I will expect to receive a fair and equal amount of playing time.

I will do my best to listen and learn from my coaches.

I will treat my coaches, other players, officials and fans with respect, and I will expect to be treated the same.

I deserve to have fun during my sports experience and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun.

I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol and expect adults to refrain from their use at all games.

I will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some way because it's important to me.

I will do my very best in school.

I will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun.

Consequences:

Umpire/referee will first warn coach of player's behavior.

If poor behavior continues, then that player will be removed from the game.

Play will not resume until that player leaves the premises.

Team with violating player will forfeit if they refuse to leave.

Player suspension or termination may be discussed and acted upon by the Erving Recreation Commission.

Parents Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents Code of Conduct.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game and practice.

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all games.

I will remember that the game is for children – not adults.

I will do my very best to make the game fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect.

I promise to help my child enjoy the game experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, possibly assisting with coaching, and possibly providing transportation and participating in league events.

Consequences:
